**Position:** Psychiatrist (Part-Time)

**Job Location:** Bronx, NY

**Position Reports To:** Program Director

**SUMMARY:** Performs psychiatric assessments upon admission and assist in elaborating on a plan of treatment to be followed by multi disciplinary team. Performs follow-up assessments to determine mental health status of each resident and plans for discharge, as needed.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES** include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Performs psychiatric assessments upon admission.
- Discusses treatment plans with the team which assist in formulating treatment goals, as needed.
- Reassess resident's mental health status routinely and periodically prior to Utilization Review.
- Provides in-service training and consultation to staff.
- Responsible for oversight of prescriptive medications.
- Assists in ordering medical supplies and equipment.
- Documents all treatment recommendations and will maintain appropriate records and all reports in an organized, timely, and accurate manner.
- Adheres to professional ethics, Agency policy, and governmental regulations
- Assist in prescribing PPD for residents and staff, implanted on site.

## **CRITICAL RESULTS/IMPACT:**

Determines the mental health status and needs of all residents at Intake prescribes a plan of treatment, and continues periodic reassessments until the finalization of discharge planning.

## **Qualifications:**

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Currently licensed as a Physician by the New York State Department of Education and who is certified by, or eligible to be certified by the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology, specialized training and prior experience in treating the emotionally handicapped. Additional skills with another language and American Sign Language preferred. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
